

The project «Women War and Peace » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Applicable to Strand 1 European Remembrance

Participation: The project in Spain involved 247 citizens (133 female, 114 male) in five public activities notably 212 participants from the city of Valencia, **Spain** and 35 attending the international webinar. A further 19,962 were reached through dissemination activities.

Location/ Dates: The events took place in **Valencia, Spain, from 04/11/2016 to 29/11/2016, in the following locations:**

In relation to events in Spain:

The day of 4 November 2016, Event One, was dedicated to the public presentation of the WWP project, distribution of final project materials, a screening of the WWP film followed by a debate and an award was made to Pilar Tendillo, one of the women included in the WWP Digital book, attended by 50 citizens.

The day of 15 November 2016, Event Two, was attended by 33 citizens, and the aim was a public presentation of the WWP project, distribution of final project material and a screening of the WWP film followed by a debate.

The day of 29 November 2016, Event Three, attended by 21 citizens was dedicated to a public presentation of the WWP project, distribution of the final project material and a screening of the WWP film followed by a debate.

The day of 29 November 2016, Event Four, attended by 108 citizens was dedicated to a public presentation of the WWP project, distribution of the final project material and a screening of the WWP film followed by a debate.

The day of 8 November 2016, Event Five, was an international webinar attended by 35, to transmit the launch of the Women War and Peace Digital book from Dublin.
