FISPE events have been carried out within this project:

Event 1 - Festival of Solidarity and Citizenship

Participation: The event involved childrens and adults with migrant origins citizens and some body authorities, including 20 participants from the city of the 17th district of Paris, France.

Location / Dates: The event took place in 10 rue André Brechet, 75017 Paris (**France**), on 29th february 2020.

Short description: The aim of the event was a workshop to present the project EU 1979 and discuss with the participants about: European values and citizenship and gender equity to people who live in a poor area of Paris.

Event 2 - Show & Activities Women's day commemoration

Participation: The event involved general adult citizens and some local organisations , including 17 participants from the city of Paris (**France**).

Location / Dates: The event took place 145 rue Belliard, 75018 Paris, **France**, on 9th march 2020.

Short description: The aim of the event was to présent of the project EU 1979 to the migrants women who live in a poor area of the 18th district of Paris with a general round table about gender equity and the situation of the women's yesterday and today.

Event 3 - Show & Activities MVAC 17 districts of Paris (*Maison de la Vie Associative et Citoyenne du 17ème*)

Participation: The event involved general adult citizens and some local organisations , including 22 participants from the city of Paris (**France**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in 25, Rue Lantiez 75017(Paris, **France**), on 12th march 2020

Short description: The aim of the event was to présent of the project EU 1979 to the neighborhood residents, neighborhood social and cultural organisations who live and work in 17th district of Paris with a spécial music show where the artists presented musics about women's empowerment and a group discussion with all the participants based on gender equity and the women's situation yesterday and today.

Event 4 – Conference - Commemoration of the European Heritage Day

Participation: The event involved general citizens and some local organisations , including 13 participants from the city of Paris (**France**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in 25, Rue Lantiez (Paris, **France**), on 19th september 2020

Short description: The aim of the event was to celebrate the European Heritage day by a conference open to the general public, where the project was presented and some activities about: European Parliament's in general, the history of the 1979 elections (presentation of some french MEP's biographies) and gender equity.

This event were created with the collaboration with the Europe House of Paris and a special guest: an actual french MEP - Mme Yembou Salima

Event 5 – Philosophy Coffee Workshop

Participation: The event involved children with migrant origins, including 8 participants from 18th district of Paris (France).

Location / Dates: The event took place in 1 rue Camille Blaisot - 75017 Paris, France, on 17th October 2020.

Short description: The aim of the event was to present the project EU 1979 and a round table to discuss the values of the European Union, gender equity and the importance of citizenship with children with migrant origins who live in a poor area of Paris by a round table.

Event 6 – RESOLVE NETWORK YOUTH CONFERENCE 2020 - UN's 75th Anniversary

Participation: The project involved citizens, notably 73 participants from the city of 33 different countries around the world.

Location/ Dates: The event took place online – ZOOM meeting on 10 December 2020.

Short description: International conference about 1325 United Nations Resolution - TOPIC - GENDER EQUITY - WOMEN POLITICAL PARTICIPATION. General project presentations where the online exposition was shown and shared with all the participants. All the topics of this project were discussed in small groups.

The day of 10 December was dedicated to the celebration of the 75th birthday of the United Nations by a International Conference

Event 7 – ONLINE CONFERENCE EU - 1979 - A People's Parliament

Participation: The project involved citizens, notably 53 participants from the city of 7 different countries (France, Greece, Portugal, Germany, Belgium, United States of America and Croatia) connected on ZOOM and 10 participants connected on Facebook live + 50 extra views of the conference from the date of the publication until 25/03/2021.

Location/ Dates: The event took place online – ZOOM meeting on 20 February 2021.

Short description: International conference about the project and the online exhibition with the participation of 1 French MEP - Mme Yambou Salima, one Political Scientist specialized in Global politics (Maria Calleweir), one Political Scientist specialized in European Governance and External Relations and 2 of the French artists who participated in the exhibition (Snjezana Simic and Michel Dizel).

Event 8 – ONLINE CONFERENCE EU - 1979 - A People's Parliament

Participation: The project involved citizens, including 25 participants from the city of Paris (France) and 86 participants connected on Facebook live + 6 extra views of the conference from the date of the publication until 25/03/2021.

Location/ Dates: The event took place online – ZOOM meeting on 24 February 2021.

Short description: International conference about the project and the online exhibition with the participation of 3 local politicians from the 17th district of Paris - Scévelenole de LIVONNIERE, Benjamin MALO and Lourdes FERNANDES and 1 of the French artist who participated in the exhibition (Michel Dizel). The Women's political participation in our district.

Event 9 - Intervention in FISPE Courses

Participation: The event involved general migrants from the 17th district of Paris (FISPE Students), including 12 participants from the city of Paris (France).

Location / Dates: The event took place online - ZOOM Tuesday courses, on 9th March 2021.
