Event 1: Intersectional Women's Day

Participation: 113 via Youtube and 204 via livestream event

Location/ Dates: Arminius Rotterdam

Short description:

During international Women's Day we organised an event on March 8th where we send the attendees the link to the online exhibition made by Smashing Times together with the partners. During a livestream event we talked about the struggles women have in our modern society. We called the event intersectional Women's Day because they way women vote and the struggles women face today are not solely based on one of their identities. We had a panel of young women whom talked about their intersectional struggles and how they vote and think representation matters, a spoken word performances based on what the artist saw in the exhibition online and a key-note from someone who explained what intersectionality is and how that plays a part in Women's lives.

The event was in collaboration with the youth department of Dona Daria, SPACE and Lilith magazine, an intersectional women's platform. The events was supported by the City of Rotterdam.

The event was later published online, where 113 people watched it.
